A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF A HERITAGE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN AND JAMES AND MARY-JANE DAVISON

WHEREAS:

- 1. James Davison and Mary-Jane Davison have applied to the Town of Lincoln for a Heritage Restoration and Improvement Grant for their property on lands described as 4170 Fly Road, Campden, being Part of Lot 8, Concession 7 and Part of Lot 18, Plan M13, in the former Township of Clinton;
- 2. Section 39(1) of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18 provides that a municipality may enter into an agreement concerning a grant to the owner of a property designated under the Act for the cost of alteration of such designated property;
- 3. The Council of the Town of Lincoln deems it expedient to enter into a Heritage Restoration and Improvement Grant with the said James Davison and Mary-Jane Davison;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Mayor and Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to prepare and execute a Heritage Restoration and Improvement Grant with the said James Leslie Davison and Mary-Jane Davison.
- 2. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
